Welcome to the Healy Theater!

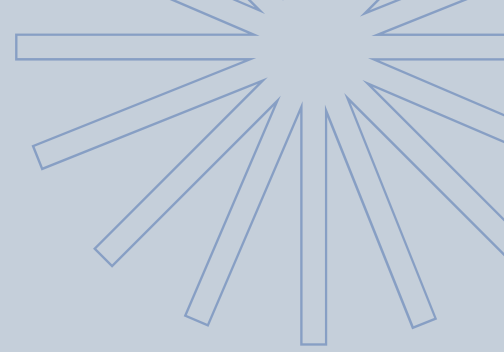
